They are using the smartpens for this type of assessment in which the student is asked to tell a story. Narrative assessment is used for children with a variety of language needs whether the primary deficit is due to disorder, delay or language deprivation, etc. It is a useful tool to determine therapy goals and/or curriculum planning.

The SLP's are collecting and calculating information on vocabulary syntax, rate, fluency and narrative structure, etc.
